Rule # 8 Team and Individual Eligibility to the State Tournament

- a. **To be eligible for Individual awards, All -Conference selections and entry into the State Tournament bowlers must have 75% of all matches bowled by his/her team. The bowler must also compete in at least 60% of the games bowled by his/her team.**
- b. **Teams must bowl a minimum of 10 matches in District Competition.**
- c. **It is recommended that all Districts follow the dates of November 1st- February 19th for District Competition.**
- d. **To qualify a Team for State Tournament no School may have players from more than on High School.**
The following will be considered exceptions of the rule, however all exceptions must fill out an “Application for Cooperative Bowling Team” on or before November 1st

Exceptions to the rule:

Multiple School participation will be allowed if a School cannot field a Team of 5 players. Said Team may collect players from other Schools as long as no other Bowling Team exists from that school.

Multiple Teams from a High School is allowed, however only one Team per High School is allowed entry into the State Tournament.

District Coordinators may allow teams to play in local meets that do not meet these guidelines; however these Teams and players are ineligible for the State Tournament.

- e. **Exceptions will be made for home School children. Please follow the same Procedure as a Cooperative Bowling Team.**
- f. **To be eligible for team or singles, all teams and players must fill out the Required State Event package and return it no later than one week prior to the State Tournament event.**
- g. **All players competing at the State Tournament must be in grades 9-12.**
- h. **Being Friends , Family, Junior Bowling Teammates, Relation or Bowling Center Employees are NOT reasons to file this form.**
